## TAKING THE NEXT STEP.

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### OVERVIEW/SUMMARY

The RHS Housing Advisory Committee met Wednesday, June 28th, at the Alliant Energy Center. During the meeting, HAC members joined tables based on their affiliation (Cities/Villages, Towns, County/Residents, Developers, Private Sector, and Non-Profits). They voted on the working strategies to identify target initiatives for their Partner Group. Following the vote, each table discussed the key details necessary to begin implementing those strategies, which facilitators summarized on posters. After these robust discussions, the HAC participated in an “Open House” exercise where they visited stations with the strategy posters organized by housing priority. HAC members used sticky notes to add additional comments to the table discussion feedback and dot stickers to upvote existing comments from other HAC members. ### REGIONAL STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN

The HAC continues to progress toward a shortlist of measurable, achievable strategies that can be implemented over the next 3-5 years throughout Dane County.



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## **STRATEGY SPOTLIGHT**

The meeting included a Strategy Spotlight presentation from Casey Slaughter Becker, Administrative Director of the Dane County Housing Access and Affordability Division (HAA), and an address from Olivia Parry, Senior Planner of the Dane County Planning and Development Department.

Casey lead HAC members through the background and current structure of the Dane County HAA. Casey shared information about the Community Development Block Grant, the Dane County Affordable Housing Development Fund, and the Housing Stability Unit. Casey concluded with details on how the HAA Division could partner with each community.

Olivia discussed the County's roles to support implementing the Regional Housing Strategy. Key roles included: 1) Supporting RHS Executive/Implementation Committee meetings, 2) Communicating on RHS activities, 3) Overseeing metrics and annual evaluation survey, 4) Contracting a manager for County-funded RHS strategies, and 5) Providing educational programming support and technical assistance to assist County stakeholders in implementing the target strategies.
